According to the United Nations, one out of every out-of-school child is in Africa. Statistics have shown that this is adversely affecting Africa's economy and growth. The saddening fact about these statistics is that these children are used for different inhumane activities that no child should ever experience. Some of which include:

Terrorism:

The United Nations
(UN) reported that in
2017, "115 children 3 8 boys and 77
girls"had been used as
human bombs. This is
in 2017 alone. Some of
these children were abducted by the
notorious sect in Northern Nigeria,
Boko Haram.

Child Marriages:

The stay-at-home decision that was made by many of these children and their parents has led to several unhealthy things such as early marriages, unwanted pregnancies, and the worst of all, recruitment by religious extremists such as Boko Haram.

Poverty:

As a result of the negative impact terrorism has had on the economy, several parents have been unable to send their children back to school or pay for their academic expenses.

The children stay in school throughout the academic session, shielding them from the difficult economy their families might be going through.

Completing school building projects and taking care of their welfare as they get educated have helped the children feel cared for and open to learning.



The month of September every year is when we commence our Back to School campaign. The positive impact we have been able to make in the lives of the children has immensely encouraged us. Last year, we were able to take on 80 new children on the back to School campaign because of the generous giving we received.


The Back to School campaign helps to keep the children in school through another academic year and ensure their welfare and academic needs are met.
